Delaware County Soil and Water Conservation District Stream Program intern positions

The Delaware County Soil and Water Conservation District (DCSWCD) Stream Program seeks to hire 3 interns to assist Stream Program staff with a multitude of tasks.

Stream Program internship description:

Stream Program interns will support stream assessment, research, and engineering efforts of the DCSWCD throughout Delaware County, NY.

Intern tasks will include:

- Documenting streambank erosion and stream instabilities with the use of GPS
- Collecting data for streambank erosion and sediment transport studies
- Monitoring riparian stream buffer plantings
- Surveying and collecting sediment data in preparation for restoration project design
- Assisting field staff with construction oversight

Qualifications include:

Interest in working outdoors with the ability to perform physically demanding work in all weather conditions. Must have a valid NYS driver's license and excellent communication skills. The ability to use ArcGIS and Microsoft Excel is preferred.

Work schedule:

These intern positions are full time (40 hours per week), beginning the first week in June and ending in late August (approximately 12 weeks). Pay rate will be \$17.30 per hour. Interns may adjust their schedule as needed to accommodate for time off, pending approval from their supervisor.
